Hematologist Oncologist Health Services Authority



Dr Lundie Richards is a Consultant Medical Hematologist-Oncologist at the Health Services Authority (HSA) and has been part of the organization's Internal Medicine, Pathology Laboratory and Hematology Oncology teams since 2019. He has been voted best Oncologist in 2023 by the Best of Cayman Islands awards. For more than 30 years he has specialized

in treating patients with a variety of cancers especially those requiring systemic treatments with chemotherapy, immune and targeted therapies, and endocrine therapy; and non-cancerous hematological conditions (abnormal blood disorders – such as anemia and bleeding conditions) and provides direct oversight for blood banking and transfusion medicine, and all matters related to clinical and laboratory hematology. He is also the Head of Department (HOD) for Internal Medicine as a Consultant physician managing patients with multiple general medical conditions.

He holds a Doctor of Medicine degree in Clinical Hematology with specialist training in internal medicine and hematology and medical oncology and has specialist training and qualifications in Transfusion Medicine, Public Health, and Health Management, and is a Certified Health Executive.

A critical component of his work is to assess and manage patients with non- cancer blood disorders as well as those who present with various cancers, designing chemotherapeutic, immunotherapy and endocrine treatment plans as required. He chairs the Multidisciplinary Tumor Board and participates in operational research, and training teaching of residents and medical interns. He is fluent in both Spanish and English and enjoys cricket.

MD, UHealth International




Dr. Janaki Sharma, MD, is a board-certified medical oncologist who treats genitourinary tumors (adrenal, kidney, prostate, bladder, and testis). Her current research interests focus on development of novel therapeutic approaches for prostate cancer. She received her M.D. degree from the University of Kansas School of Medicine and completed clinical fellowships in geriatric medicine, medical oncology and hematology at Albert Einstein College of Medicine in New York.

Dr. Sharma served as an Assistant Professor of Genitourinary medical oncology at Albert Einstein College of Medicine from 2016-2019 and joined Sylvester Comprehensive Cancer Center / University of Miami Health System in 2019. She is passionate about medical education and has served as the Program Director of the Hematology Oncology Fellowship Program from June 2021.

Dr. Nahleh is Vice Chair for Cancer Institute, Director of the Maroone Cancer Center and Chair of the Hematology-Oncology Division at Cleveland Clinic Florida. She subspecializes in Breast Cancer. Her research focuses on innovative treatment of breast cancer, cancer survivorship care, cancer disparity and improving the quality of life of patients with cancer. Dr. Nahleh is a member in the ASCO Advisory and Guideline Methodology committees. Dr. Nahleh has received numerous awards including the "Patient Experience Medal of Excellence" in 2022. Dr Nahleh has authored over 100 articles in the field of cancer, cancer disparities and breast cancer research. She has presented in national and international cancer meetings and serves on the editorial board of numerous medical journals. Dr. Nahleh has American Board certification in Oncology.
